Criteria for Junior Membership:

The supporting Members should ensure that the person has a genuine desire, to learn the game of golf if they have not already played elsewhere.

Evidence of lessons, playing as a guest or any existing membership elsewhere should be asked for. The supporting Members must ensure that the Applicant is of good character and behaviour and that they know of no sound reason why they should not be admitted.

A young person over five but under the age of 18 years on the 1st January in any year may apply to become a Junior Member, but Membership will not be offered to Juniors until he/she attains 8 years of age. Should a Junior under 8 years of age head any waiting list he/she will remain at the top until they attain the age of 8 years.

The Proposer and Seconder should ensure that the prospective Junior Member is aware that transfer into Intermediate or Full Membership may not be offered automatically on attaining 18 or 24 years of age.

No member may propose or second more than 3 Juniors for Membership within the same calendar year unless the first Applicant has been admitted to Membership or withdrawn from the Waiting List.

Members, in supporting any Application, are by implication confirming that the above criteria have been met.

In accordance with Club Rules, this form should be sent to the Managing Secretary, along with letters of introduction from both the sponsor and seconder, for consideration by the Committee.
